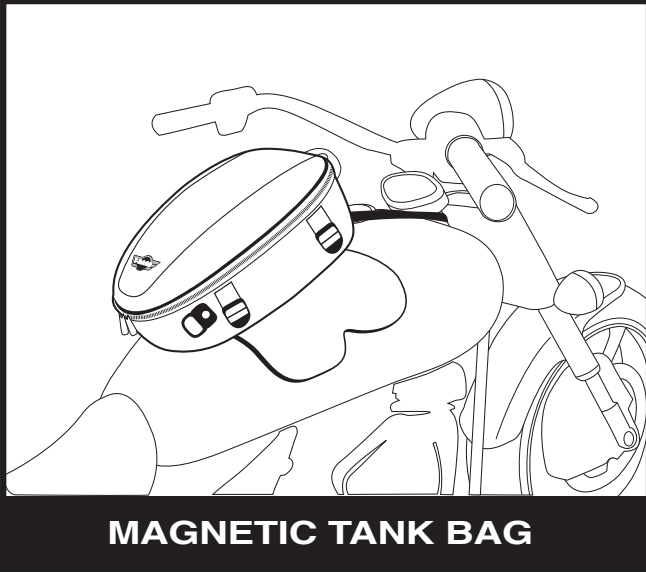




TANK-N-TAIL BAG



MAGNETIC TANK BAG

This T-BAG is designed for use as a magnetic tank bag, a tail pack for motorcycles with quick release passenger seat pads & a backpack.

AS A TANK BAG

1. Your T-Bag has flaps attached to the bottom of the bag. Each contoured flap has 3 powerful rare earth magnets to secure the bag to the contour of your gas tank.
2. Before riding, the safety (yoke) strap must be attached around the steering head or other secure anchor point near the steering head as shown in the drawing above
3. After the strap is securely wrapped around the steering head, pull it tight and hook the snap hook onto the D-ring located under the carrying handle on the bag.
4. Adjust the strap until it is snug between the bag and the tie down point.
5. Adjust the sliding lock tri-bar to lock down the loose end of the strap or you can cut the strap to a shorter length and seal the end with a flame.
6. DO NOT allow loose straps anywhere on your motorcycle because they may become entangled in moving parts of the motorcycle, thereby causing loss of control and it may result in serious injury or death. The loose straps can also flap in the wind and damage your paint.
7. Each bag has detachable backpack straps included. Snap the backpack strap ends to the 3 D-rings on the outside of the bag for convenient carrying

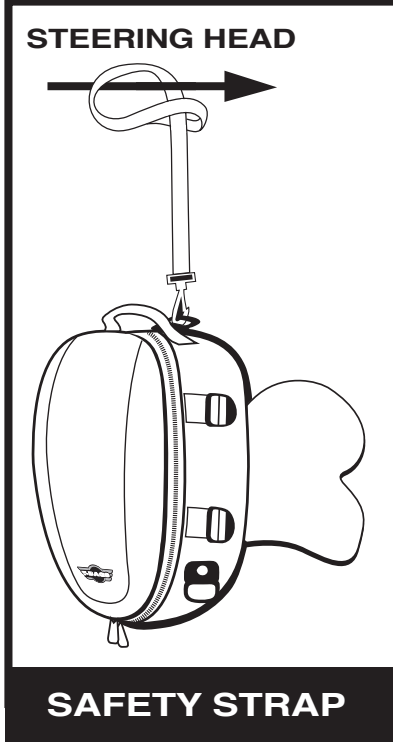
BEFORE RIDING check to be certain that the safety (yoke) strap does not interfere with the full operation of the forks, control cables, wiring or restrict the "full" turning capabilities of the handlebars. Do not ride with this bag until you are sure nothing interferes with the normal operation or control of the motorcycle.

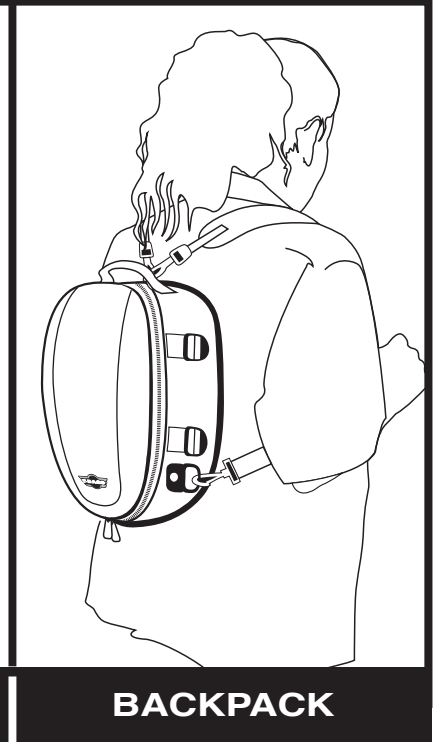

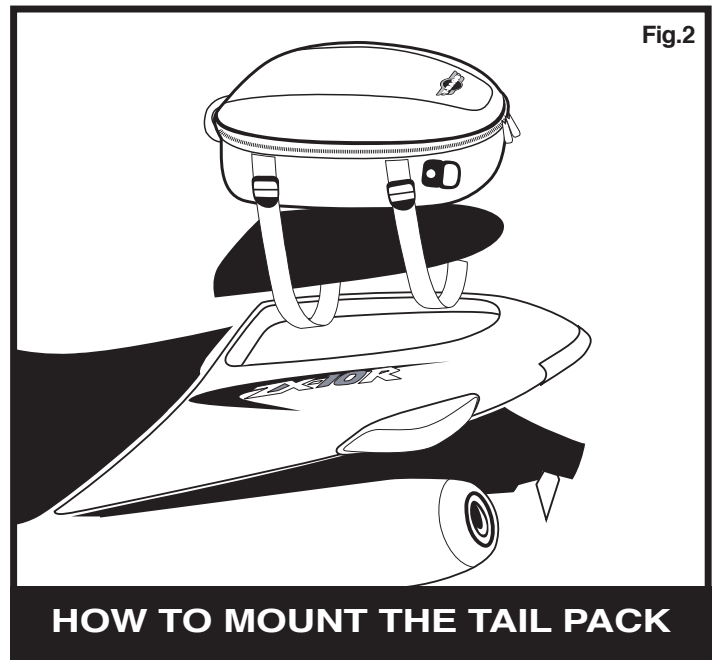
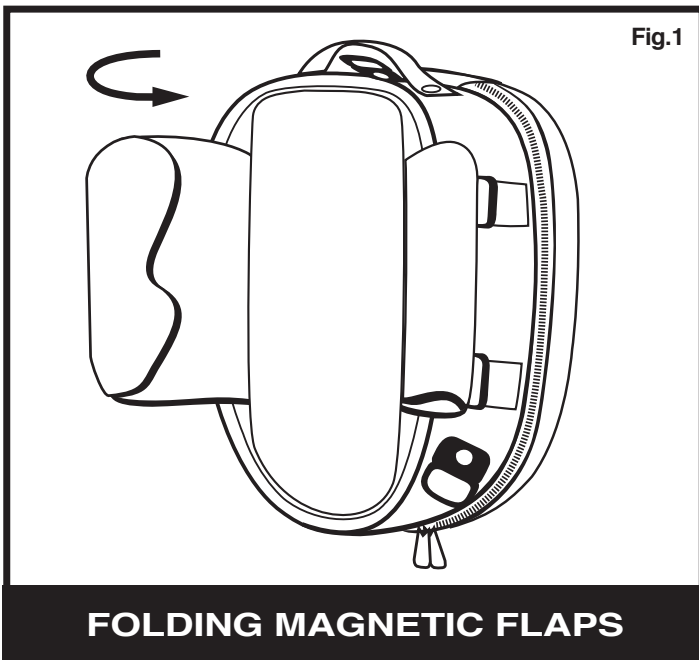


SAFETY STRAP



BACKPACK

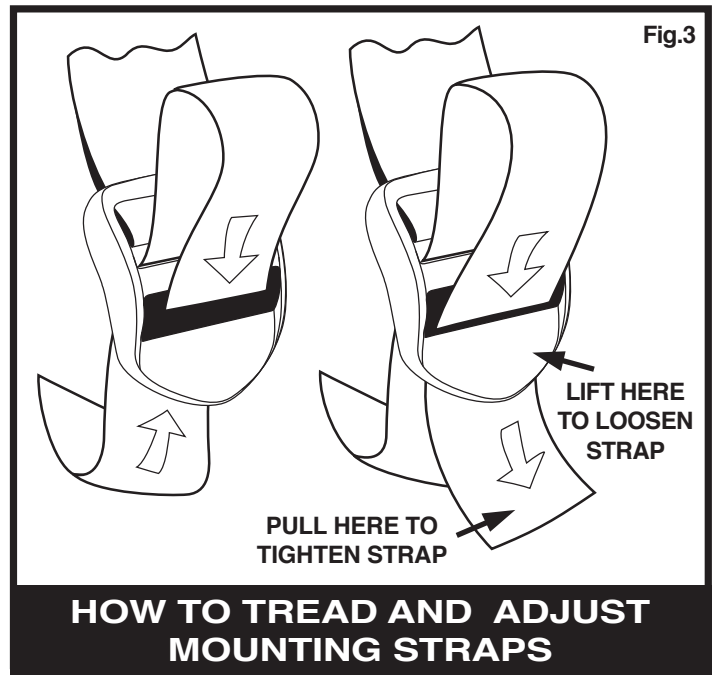
TANK-N-TAIL BAG



This T-BAG is designed for use as a magnetic tank bag, a tail pack for motorcycles with quick release passenger seat pads & a backpack.

AS A TAIL BAG

1. To use as a tail bag, tuck the magnetic flaps completely under the center compartment on the bottom of the bag. (Fig.1)
2. Attach the 2 straps, each through it's own buckle on one side of the bag as shown in the drawing (Fig.3, right)
3. Lay the bag upside down on it's lid, lay the straps across the bag and attach the loose ends to the corresponding 2 buckles on the other side of the bag.
4. Be sure the straps are properly laced through the buckles so the straps will tighten the bag to the seat pad and will not slip or allow the bag to loosen while riding.
5. Remove your passenger seat pad and slide in through the strap loops as shown in the drawing (Fig.2, above to the right).
6. Be sure the straps do not interfere with the mounting/locking hooks located on the under side of the removed passenger seat pad.
7. Tighten the straps until snug on the removed passenger seat pad.
8. When the bag snugly attached to the seat pad, lock the seat pad onto the motorcycle.
9. Pull on all 4 straps until the bag is very snug on the passenger seat pad. If the bag starts to deform from strap pressure, it is too tight.



BEFORE RIDING pull up on the bag to make sure all 4 straps are laced properly through the buckles so the straps will not come loose. **MAKE SURE** you tuck the loose ends of the straps in and/or tie them off to avoid entanglement in moving parts of the motorcycle. Straps can also be cut to proper length and the ends sealed with a flame.
